Weighing in PROPER TIRE PRESSURE

How do you determine what pressure to run in the tires of your fire truck, ambulance, or emergency response vehicle? If you ask this question around your station you may receive a myriad of answers ranging from the pressure marked on the tires, the pressures noted on the **Pierce** job sticker or door jamb, or even a pressure based on what someone's

brother runs in their dump trucks or their own pickup truck. The weight stickers or markings on the tires are good resources; without more information, they can at least get you into a safe range but will most likely leave your tires overinflated.

If you look at the weight rating sticker in the cab or on the door jamb you will note that it lists the GVWR (gross vehicle weight rating), the GAWR (gross axle weight rating) for each axle, and a corresponding tire pressure for each axle. If you have nothing else to go on, this pressure would be a safe starting point for your tires, however, unless you are fully loaded to the GVWR of the vehicle your tires will likely end up overinflated.



Looking at the tire itself you will find the load range information. This will give you the maximum load the tire can carry at full inflation. The tire pressure listed here is the maximum pressure for this tire. Since tires are sized by the manufacturer to be able to carry the GVWR of the vehicle, in most cases you will not need to inflate a tire to this maximum pressure and doing so will often cause over inflation.

So, what is the best way to choose the ideal tire pressure for your application? Weigh the vehicle to determine the

actual GVW (gross vehicle weight) and GAWs (gross axle weights) so you know how much load is on each tire. Here at **GLICK Fire Equipment** we have a set of portable scales that can be used to determine the weight of each axle, or a member of your company may have access to a scale in your community. Several different industries have large drive-on scales and will let you weigh your vehicles at little or no cost. Check out scrap yards, landfills, feed mills, landscape supply yards, or even a local farm. If you do use an inground scale it is important to weigh each axle separately as well as getting an overall weight. Don't forget to factor in a truck full of first responders in full turnout gear.

Once you have the GVW and GAWs you can calculate the ideal tire pressures for each axle. Armed with your tire's brand, model number and size, go to the tire manufacturer's website and find the load and inflation chart for your specific tire. If you find your tire size and follow the chart over to the measured weight on that tire (weight of the axle divided by 2 (single tire) or 4 (dual tires) you will find the proper inflation level for that tire. If you are between two weights always round up to the higher weight.

Having your tires properly inflated can prevent premature wear, provide better traction, improve ride quality, prevent overheated tires, help fuel economy, and prevent tire damage. Once you have calculated the ideal pressures for your truck it is often a good idea to mark it on or in the truck somewhere so anyone checking the tires can access the proper pressure settings. Some of our customers have had placards made and mounted them above each wheel. This is a good way to help ensure the tires are always set to the ideal pressure



If you have a **Pierce** fire truck with a **TAK 4 suspension** it is also recommended that you check ride height after a tire pressure change or weight change to the truck. **GLICK Fire Equipment's** service department has all of the required tools to weigh your truck, check and adjust tire pressures, and set up your **TAK 4 suspension** for the proper ride height.

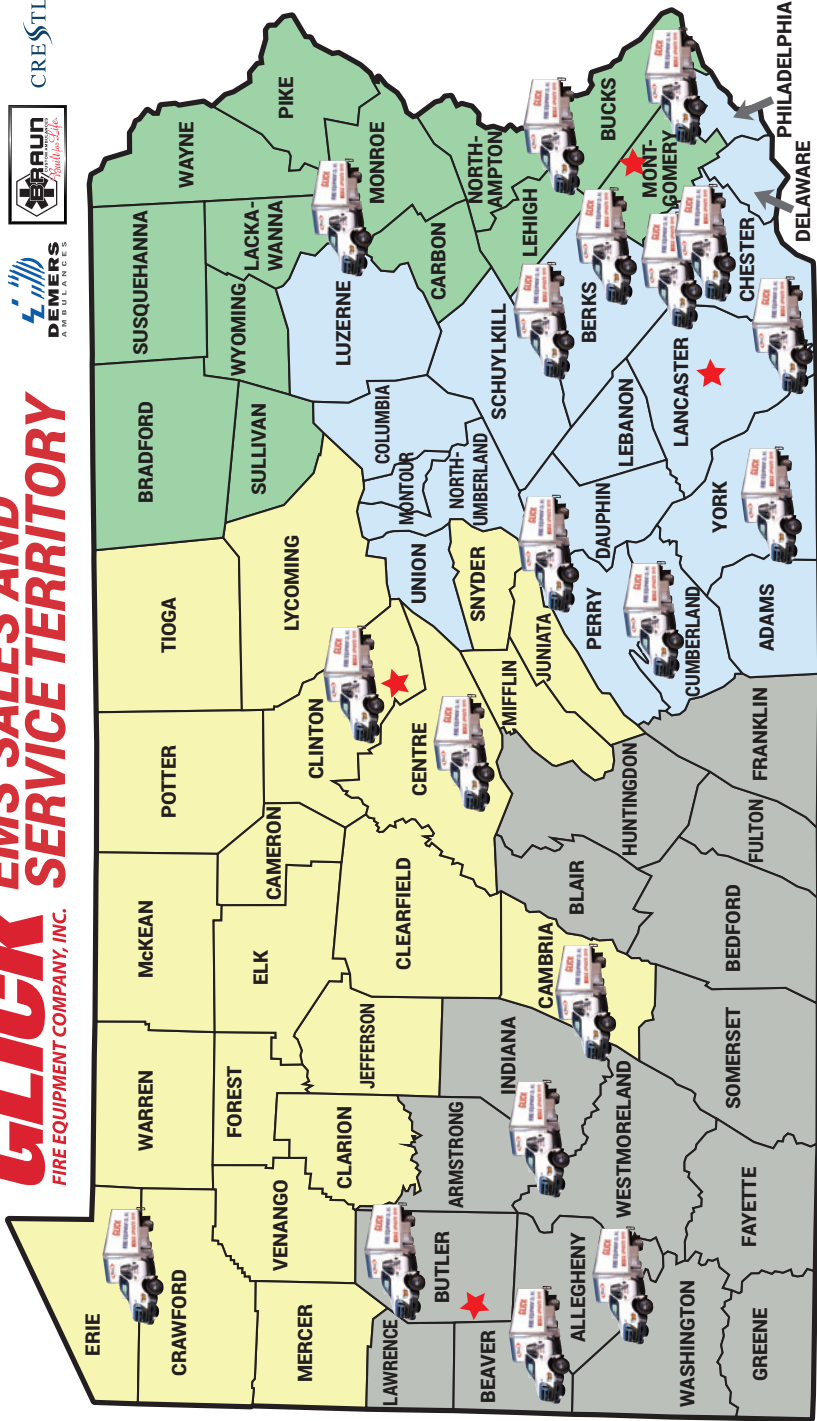

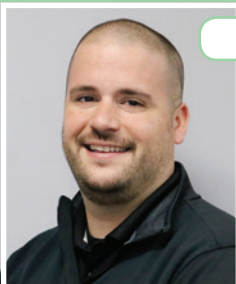
