- 1/2 cup butter, cubed
- 1/3 cup flour
- 2 teaspoons paprika
- 1 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon black pepper
- 10 chicken wingettes, thawed
- dipping sauces (optional)
- fresh parsley (optional)

Preheat oven to 425°F.

Line baking sheet with foil. Arrange butter cubes on foil.

In medium bowl, combine flour, paprika, garlic powder, salt and pepper.

Coat both sides of wings in flour mixture then evenly space among butter cubes on baking sheet.

Bake wings 30 minutes. Turn wings over and bake another 15 minutes, or until crispy and fully cooked.

Serve with dipping sauces and sprinkle with fresh parsley, if desired.

BEYOND THE OIL CHANGE:



Is Your Apparatus Getting the Proper Maintenance?

In our last issue we discussed how frequently you should be performing maintenance on your emergency apparatus; this time we will be looking at what maintenance items you should be considering. If you take your pumper to the same garage that services your dump truck or tractor trailer and ask for PMs (preventative maintenance) you may not be getting all of the service that it needs.

Many truck shops will consider a PM request to simply mean greasing the chassis and an oil change. This could be as basic as just greasing the suspension and driveline, changing the engine oil and filter, and checking all fluid levels; or may include additional items such as replacing the transmission filters, checking coolant protection levels, testing the batteries, replacing the fuel filters, and changing out a dirty air filter as needed. It is important to have a good understanding of what services will be performed so you can ensure that all systems on your truck receive regular maintenance to prevent breakdowns or premature wear on vital components.

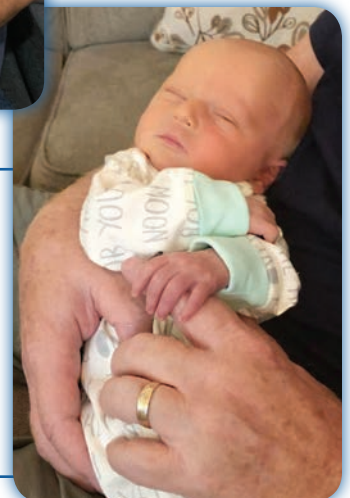

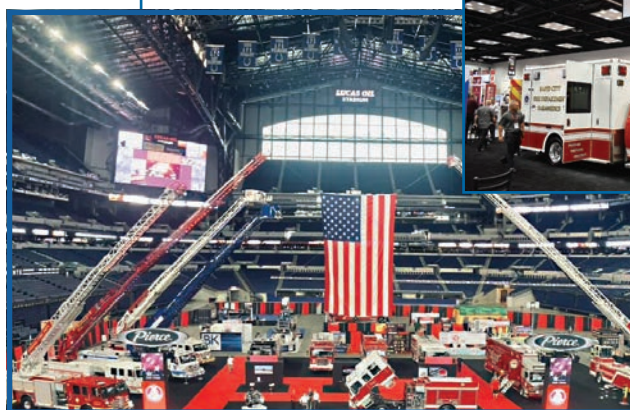

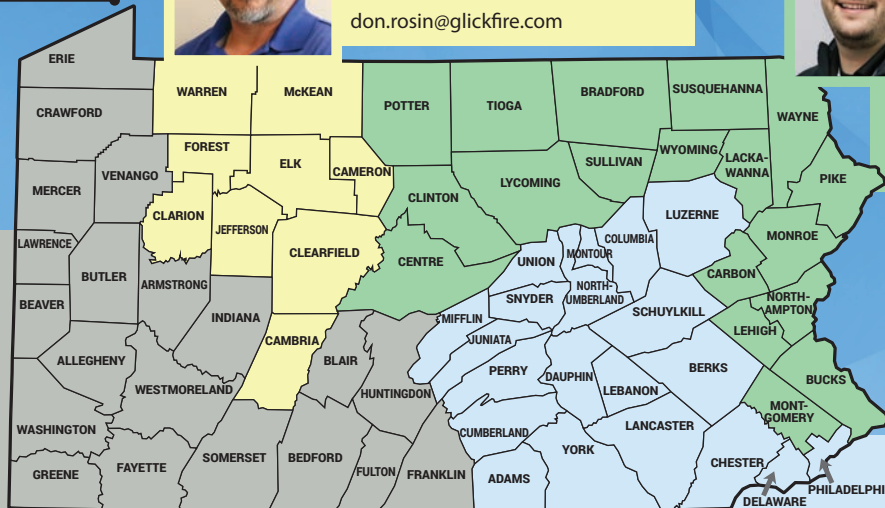
