Winter Conditions?


As the leaves change and the crisp scent of snow fills the air, winter—and the challenging weather it brings—is quickly approaching. Severe conditions should never compromise emergency response times.

To ensure your department's apparatus are ready for any emergency in any weather, consider these key questions:

- Has the truck been Carwelled?
- Are the cab's heating and defrost systems functioning properly?
- Has the engine coolant been tested?
- Do the pump drains operate correctly?
- Does the pump remain dry after draining? (If not, valves may need attention.)
- Are the automatic snow chains working as intended?
- Are traditional snow chains in good condition?
- Is tire tread sufficient for snow?
- Are wiper blades and washer fluid winter-ready?
- Has fuel conditioner been added?

• Have you considered the benefits of installing cold-weather accessories, like heat shields and a pump house heater, to help protect the pump and related components from cold conditions?

Addressing these concerns will help keep your apparatus prepared for the winter months ahead.

**SAFETY OPERATIONS**

Preparing fire apparatus for winter is essential, and many departments also review cold-weather operations to ensure safety.

Key steps include:

- Keeping sand and salt at stations and emergency scenes to prevent slips.
- Refreshing firefighter training on cold-weather procedures and equipment like pump heaters, chains, and heat shields.
- Reviewing SOPs for wet/dry pump use and proper engagement on scene.



Winter can be harsh, but with the right equipment and preparation, firefighters can safely manage cold, snowy conditions.







FIREHOUSE GRUB

Skillet Lasagna (Servings: 4-6)



- 1 pound ground beef
- 1/2 cup ricotta
- 1 tablespoon onion powder
- 1-1/2 cups frozen spinach
- 1 tablespoon garlic powder
- 9 lasagna noodles
- salt, to taste
- pepper, to taste
- 44 ounces marinara sauce
- 1 cup mozzarella cheese
- 1/2 cup heavy whipping cream
- bread, for serving
- Parmesan cheese, for topping (optional)

In large skillet or Dutch oven, brown ground beef with onion powder, garlic powder and salt and pepper, to taste. Drain excess grease. Mix in marinara sauce, heavy whipping cream, ricotta and spinach.

Break up lasagna noodles and add to skillet. Cover and let set over medium heat 10 minutes. Stir and top with mozzarella cheese. Cover and let set 10 minutes.

Serve with bread and top with Parmesan cheese, if desired.


