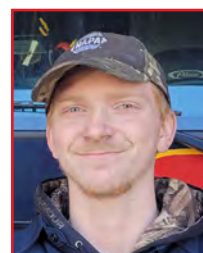

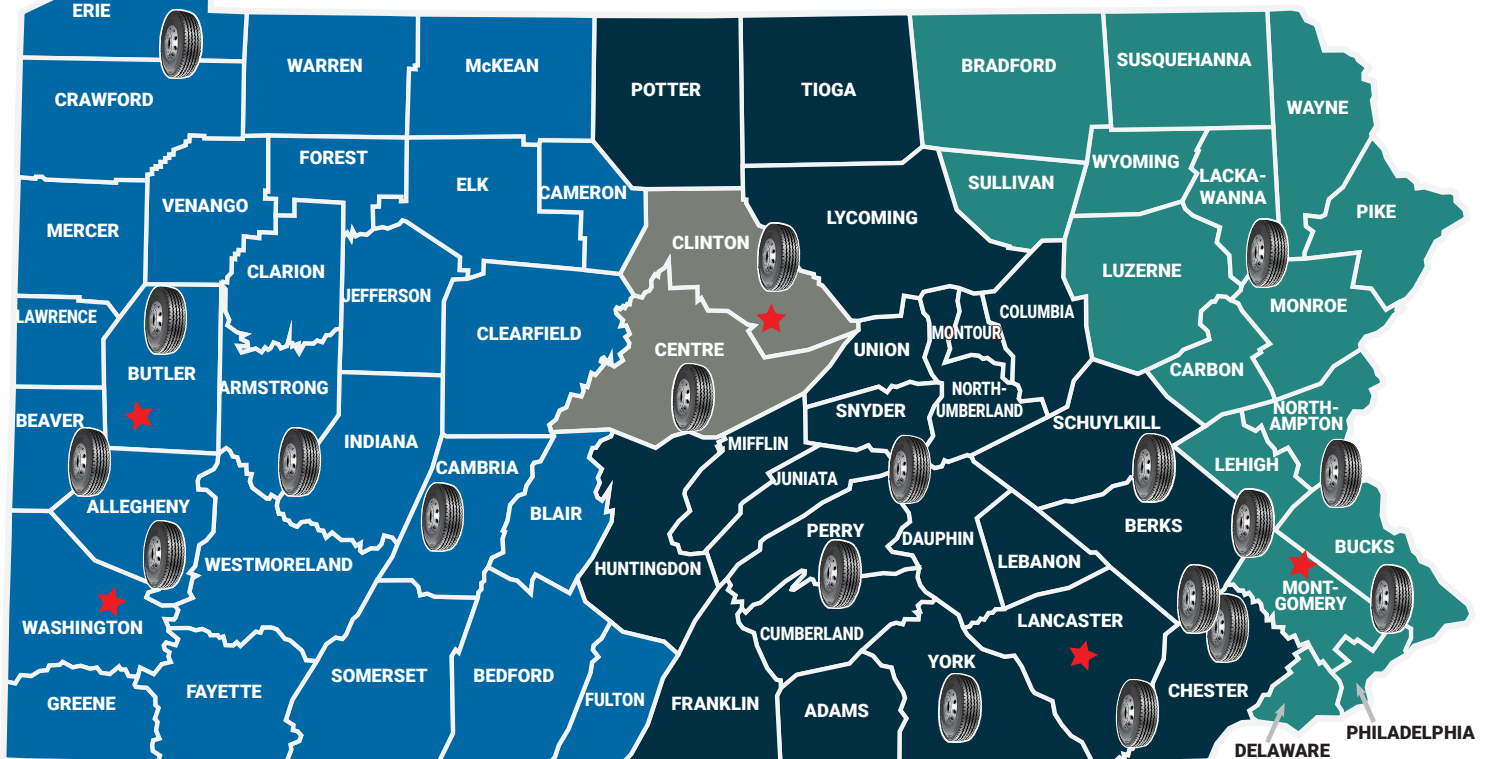

✓ Air Conditioning Units

As Spring arrives and temperatures begin to rise, it's an ideal time to ensure your apparatus is fully prepared for the months ahead. Proper maintenance of your air conditioning system now can prevent performance issues during peak heat and ensure operator comfort and safety.

Each department should routinely inspect and service the A/C unit on its apparatus, including recharging the system if necessary. Don't wait until extreme heat exposes performance issues. Our comprehensive, multi-point inspection evaluates the entire system to confirm it is operating at peak efficiency.

✓ COMPRESSOR

We verify that the correct type and proper amount of oil are present in your air conditioning system. Excessive heat, incorrect oil, or low oil levels can significantly reduce compressor life and lead to premature failure. Regardless of the fire apparatus manufacturer, our technicians identify the appropriate oil specifications and ensure the system is properly serviced.

✓ EVAPORATOR

While evaporators are often said to be maintenance-free, over time they can become clogged with dust, lint, and other debris. These contaminants restrict airflow by adhering to cooling fins and can also promote mold or bacterial growth. If you notice an unpleasant odor when activating the A/C system, it is often a sign that evaporator service is needed. Installing an evaporator filter—if one is not already present—can help reduce contamination and extend system life.



✓ CONDENSER

Condensers are also susceptible to dirt and debris. A routine visual inspection of condenser fans can identify potential issues early. Units mounted on top of the apparatus may collect leaves or branches, while those located in the engine compartment can be affected by road debris. In many cases, a thorough cleaning can quickly restore lost performance.

✓ LEAKS

Typically, an air conditioning system that does not cool well is a symptom of a leak somewhere in the system. Our **GLICK** Service Technicians use diagnostic gauges to evaluate pressure levels throughout the system and accurately pinpoint any leaks.

You can also perform a basic inspection by checking fittings, hoses, the condenser, compressor connections, and shaft seals. Any visible refrigerant oil may indicate a leak.

If you suspect an issue, contact us to review your service options and prevent further damage.

CHECK-UPS:

☑ Pump Service & Testing

Today's fire trucks are built with many complex systems. Those systems all require maintenance to keep your front line truck ready. One of those components at the heart of the truck is the fire pump, and it's no exception when it comes to some basic maintenance.

GLICK offers service and pump testing as part of our Preventative Maintenance program. Service and testing should be done annually to ensure your apparatus will perform as expected.

CAT 7

PUMP SERVICE INCLUDES:

- Inspect and lubricate ALL ball valves and linkages
- Lubricate all required pump fittings
- Change oil in the pump transfer case
- Inspect pump shift
- Fill primer reservoir and check weep hole
- Lubricate primer linkage
- Lubricate relief valve/engine governor
- Circulate pump for minimum of 20 min. at 100 PSI (minimum)
- Check all pressure gauges
- Check tachometer operation, cab, and pump panel
- Test relief valve/engine governor
- Inspect auxiliary cooling lines
- Check pump shaft seals and packing
- Drain pump, vacuum test (10 inches for 5 minutes)
- Inspect booster tank exterior, underbody, and fill stack
- Lubricate hose reel and check swivel and brake

Pump Testing is performed to current NFPA 1911 standards. Many factors will contribute the performance of a pump, and we test multiple systems of your apparatus. Our testing will inform you of the capability of your apparatus to serve you, and we provide a written report of the capabilities, as a comparison of the performance from one year to the next.

To be sure that your pump is performing to its fullest, it should be tested annually.

Scheduling your service and test now is suggested since service tends to get busier in the warmer weather. This can be done at one of our five full-service locations across Pennsylvania, or a Mobile Service Technician can go to your facility with one of our specialized Draft Commander portable units.

1. Slice the Sausage into 1/4" thick slices.
2. Trim the chicken thighs, cut into small cubes. Season with salt, pepper and garlic.
3. Finely dice the veggies.
4. Thaw the shrimp if needed.
5. Bring chicken broth, cream of chicken, and 2 cups water to boil in large pot.
6. In cast iron skillet over medium heat, melt butter and brown the sausage until crispy dark brown. Remove from skillet.
7. In the same skillet, cook the chicken thighs. Remove from skillet.

Serves: 5

- 1 Johnsonville Cajun Andouille Sausage
- 3 lb. chicken thighs
- 1 lb. frozen shrimp (peeled & deveined)
- Minced garlic
- 1 box Bow-tie pasta
- 3 stalks celery
- 2 green bell peppers
- 1 yellow onion
- 1 box chicken broth
- 1 can Cream of Chicken 10.5oz
- Velveeta cheese (optional)
- 2 oz. butter
- Tony Chachere's Creole seasoning

8. In the same skillet, cook the shrimp. Remove from skillet.
9. In the same skillet, sauté the veggies. Add Cajun Seasoning to taste. Add the minced garlic.
10. When the broth is boiling, add in the pasta. Cook until al dente. Add velveeta cheese in cubes (if desired).
11. Once cheese is melted, add the sausage, chicken thighs, shrimp, and veggies into the pot. Remove from heat and stir until mixed.
12. Serve with cornbread

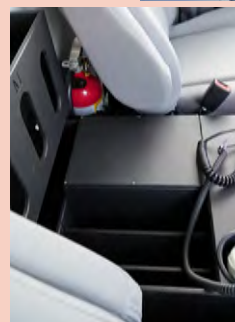
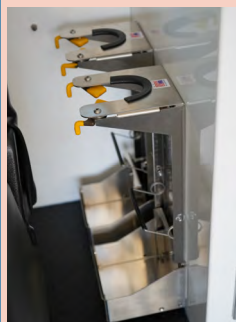

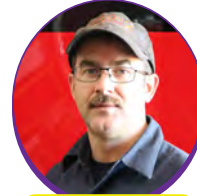
